Christian Nolte is the Senior Physician of the Department of Neurology and heads both the clinical studies team (Trial Team) at the Centre for Stroke Research Berlin (CSB) and (in collaboration) the certified, transregional Stroke Unit at the Charité Campus Benjamin Franklin (CBF). He manages the Thrombolysis and Endovascular Recanalisation Register of the CBF. His main scientific interest is the interaction between heart and brain and the treatment of acute ischaemic strokes. A main project, called Heart and Brain interaction in Acute Stroke, is a prospective observational study to examine whether an enhanced MRI investigation leads to a significant increase of the findings regarding the cause of stroke. Another project, called "Prediction of acute coronary syndrome in acute ischemic stroke", is to develop a diagnostic algorithm that allows the prediction of acute coronary syndrome in stroke patients.
